Swabbing Chick Boxes

- 1. Wash and sterilize hands thoroughly before beginning.
- 2. Put on clean gloves.
- 3. Open the swab packet by tearing along the blue line and pulling apart the seal.
- 4. Using the blue sponge, wipe the swab gently across the surface of the chick box.
- Repeat on other chick boxes at random throughout the trolleys to ensure you have swabbed 4-5 representative samples per trolley.
- 6. Place the swab back into the packet once swabbed and seal the packet tightly.
- Write the sample details on the swab and complete a sample submission form to match, make sure to include Farm name, House number and date of sampling.
- 8. Return the swab to the lab for salmonella testing within 24 to48 hours for testing.
