European Funding

- European Maritime and Fisheries Fund 2014-2020 (EMFF)
- Brexit Adjustment Reserve
- European Maritime,
 Fisheries, and Aquaculture
 Fund 2020-2027 (EMFAF)



- Opened in 2016
- Three schemes specific to aquaculture
 - Sustainable AquacultureScheme
 - Knowledge Gateway Scheme
 - Covid 19 Aquaculture
 Support Scheme



Sustainable Aquaculture Scheme

- Operational from 2016 to 2022
- 122 projects completed over the lifecycle of the scheme
- € 15 million grant aid paid through the scheme



Knowledge Gateway Scheme

- Designed to work to solve knowledge gaps and address industry issues
- 26 projects completed with total grants of €2.4 million
- Also funded BIM aquaculture development projects
- Lessons learned...



Covid 19 Aquaculture Support Scheme

- Open during 2020 and early 2021
- To support mussel and oyster farmers affected by Covid 19
- 154 applicants paid a total of €1.2 million




Brexit Adjustment Reserve


- Sustainable Aquaculture Growth Scheme (SAGS)
- Used the online grant scheme that had previously been used for the Covid 19 scheme
- Open late 2022 to August 2023
- 103 projects completed with a total value of €4.2 million
